Mail application(s) and photos to: Please Don't Die Black Men, 2700 Caples Avenue #3278, Vancouver, WA 98661. Your application **will be rejected** if submitted without a business headshot photo and a fashion designer business card. A **business headshot** is showing an individual(s) from the chest up in front of a plain background or in front of a plain background that also showcases their logo. Please attach **photo(s)** to this application. A business headshot and a shot of your business are preferred; however, professional photos are not required, but your photos should be recent (less than 1 year old).

ALL FASHION DESIGNERS MUST:

- SUBMIT A REGISTRATION FORM BEFORE THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE (DECEMBER 8, 2024). ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 1, 2024.
- Come to the dress rehearsal on February 1, 2025, 10 am 4 pm (no excuses). If you do not show up to the dress rehearsal, you will not be able to participate in the show.
- Submit a completed legible registration form with (1) business headshot and (1) company logo or photo.
- Pay a \$150 non-refundable deposit submitted with the application. Deposits may be payable with cash, check, or money order.
- **PLEASE** be sure to list a verifiable and working email address and cell phone number. Add **CEOCHAIR@PDDBM.ORG** to your contacts and check your spam regularly for emails from us.
- **BE ON TIME FOR THE SHOW.** Fashion Designer arrival time is 8 a.m. Shuttle service is available from C-Tran leaving the Vancouver Mall transit center starting at 7:30 a.m.
- On February 1, 2025, it is mandatory for each designer to complete a Collection Coordinator Sheet. These sheets serve as crucial guides for our dressers, aiding them in understanding the envisioned appearance for each model in your respective clothing lines. Furthermore, they play an integral role in presenting a cohesive and harmonious lineup for our showcase.
 - The completed Collection Coordinator Sheets will be distributed to our dedicated dressers, who will utilize the provided information to dress our

models and ensure their seamless integration into the designated spots in the lineup.

- Please be advised that the event doors will be secured at 11:45 am. While you and your guests are welcome to exit at your convenience, re-entry will not be permitted until 2 pm. We kindly request your cooperation in refraining from entering or exiting during the Black History Month Fashion Show, as this ensures a respectful and uninterrupted experience for those on stage.
- I agree to add my personal and my business Facebook page as an attendee to the 2025 PDDBM Black History Month Event page on Facebook and to promote my involvement with the show regularly on social media.
- Each fashion designer entering the show must have a separate application completed.
- All designers have the opportunity to sign up for multiple categories. However, each designer must commit to presenting a minimum of 5 distinct and completed outfits for each chosen category. This requirement is integral to ensuring a diverse and comprehensive representation of your creative expertise during the show.
- Following the conclusion of the show, all designers are expected to be prepared to facilitate the immediate sale of the five outfits per category featured in the presentation. This prompt response is integral to maximizing the momentum generated during the showcase and capitalizing on the heightened interest in our designs.
 - To ensure a smooth and efficient process, kindly make necessary arrangements, such as having adequate inventory, pricing information, and any relevant sales collateral readily available. Additionally, designate a point of contact from your team who will be responsible for handling inquiries and processing transactions.

A: There are no age, gender, sex, and/or height restrictions for the Fashion Designer Search (those under 18 must have parental/guardian permission to apply).

Black History was created to focus attention on the contributions of African Americans to the United States. It honors all Black people from all periods of U.S. history, from the enslaved people first brought over from Africa in the early 17th century to African Americans living in the United States today.

- Athletic. Athletic designs, including footwear, worn for sport or physical exercise, such as tracksuits, shorts, T-shirts, and polo shirts.
 Specialized garments include swimsuits (for swimming), wet suits (for diving or surfing), ski suits (for skiing), and leotards (for gymnastics).
 Sports footwear includes trainers, football boots, riding boots, and ice skates.
- African Inspired. African Inspired Clothing incorporates traditional African motifs and prints, vibrant colors, and modern designs. African clothing ranges from casual everyday wear to formal attire and is worn by people in Africa and diaspora communities around the world.
- Casual. Casual dress includes items like T-shirts, button-down shirts, blouses, and sweaters on top. Bottoms might include jeans, khakis, linen pants, cropped pants, or shorts. Casual shoes can include sneakers, loafers, low heels, or sandals.
- Formal Party. Formal Party dress includes any clothing worn for a party. An ankle-grazing dress and statement jewelry is a foolproof outfit, but anything from a long dress to a cocktail number, ball gowns, and long dress skirts are suitable. Guys can wear a tuxedo with a bow tie, a dark suit and tie, a windowpane blazer, solid-colored chinos, classic leather dress shoes, a white shirt + dark suit + solidcolored tie, and a business suit, including a jacket and dress pants.

- Each fashion designer must submit a separate application, including minors under the age of 18.
- I understand that I will only receive 1 free complimentary ticket per application submitted. Additional tickets must be paid for.
- I understand that my application must be **POSTMARKED** no later than December 1, 2024. Any applications and deposits that are not received by December 8, 2024, will not be accepted.
- I understand that all youth fashion designers under the age of 18 must have the Parent/Guardian Consent and Approval Section of this form signed.
- I understand that I will be given 1 vendor table and 2 chairs.
 Additional vendor tables must be paid for.

- I acknowledge the requirement to have a minimum of 5 distinct and completed designs per category for my vendor table. I am committed to ensuring that these designs are prepared and ready for sale both before and after the fashion show. This commitment aligns with the standards set forth for our upcoming event, and I am dedicated to contributing to its success.
- I understand that I must take a group photo immediately after the show is over (2 pm) backstage with all of the fashion designers, the host(s), all of the models, the DJ, and PDDBM's Chairwoman and President.
- I understand that I must always have an assistant present at my vendor table on the day of the show from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- I understand that the event doors will be secured at 11:45 am. While my guests and I are welcome to exit at your convenience, re-entry will not be permitted until 2 pm.
